Instruction

Special Education

(The board of education accepts its legal duties and responsibilities for providing special education programs for the students of this school district.

The superintendent of schools is directed to develop a comprehensive plan for compliance with all of the requirements of federal and state law for the education of all individuals with exceptional needs residing in or attending school in this school district.

Policy adopted: May 16, 1988)

The West Hartford Board of Education is committed to providing educational programs and services that support the inclusion of students with special needs in the general education classroom and curriculum, and promotes the collaborative and collective practice between general and special education to improve the learning and achievement of <u>all</u> learners.

The Superintendent of Schools and his/her designee will ensure that the district's delivery of educational services is implemented in accordance within the district's Mission and Model of Continuous Improvement and in compliance with all applicable requirements of federal and state laws.
